Record of Proceedings

March 26, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Cliff Mueller at 7:30 pm. at the Sheridan Community Room. All trustees present for Roll Call except Patty Heath. Also present Dale Smith and Juanita Sittler.

The minutes of February 27, 1992 were approved as corrected, the correction is in paragraph 3, line 7, should read "part of one old garage".

Mr. Sittler says the school board has discussed the location of the two buildings, and they can face east of the barracks. The school district will have a plot plan drawn up. The log cabin has a cement floor. The city building inspector will be asked to put into writing what needs to be done and what he will allow. A lease will be asked for from the school board for the property for the buildings. Bonita will ask Lena to attend the next meeting to assist in the planning for the move. The Sheridan Historical Society needs to prepare a plan to present to the school board and Mr. Svigel. Action needs to be taken as the Highway work will be bid soon.

A news item about Monaghans' was shown. They recently celebrated their 100 birthday on St. Patricks Day. They must have been closed during prohibition, however. The city officials attended this gala affair.

Dale Smith said that he has friends whose in-laws live in "Logantown" their name is Waite. They should be put on the list of those we can interview.

The article for this year's Sheridan Celebrates Souvenir Booklet will be on water in Sheridan. An outline will be ready soon and distributed to the committee for their suggestions.
