Record of Proceedings July 22, 1993

Trustees present: Bonita Hutcheson, Earl McCoy, Cliff Mueller, Chuck West; others present: Thea Hutcheson, Dick Lynch.

Roll Call President Bonita Hutcheson called the meeting to order; the roll call of Trustees followed, with introduction of guests present.

Approval of June 17 Minutes Cliff Mueller made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 17 meeting; Earl McCoy seconded the motion, and it carried.

Reports

Treasurer In the absence of Dale Smith, Treasurer, Vice-President Cliff Mueller reported that there is a bank balance of \$2,266.58, plus \$84.64 in the draft account. Mr. Mueller also had the bank signature cards to be signed by the new officers.

Membership The President suggested that Cliff Mueller head recruitment of members for the Sheridan Historical Society. Mueller said he plans to send the membership flyer to various lists of names; he will also put an article in the new *Sheridan Sun*, a paper published by the school district, with advertisements from local businesses and delivered door-to-door.

Building Plans Cliff Mueller discussed ideas about moving the buildings. The log building possibly could be taken apart and rebuilt at the proposed new location. The Board reviewed the July 23, 1992 letter from the Sheridan Schools. The School Board wants a schedule for moving the buildings and for improvements to the area. President Hutcheson will prepare a response to the Sheridan Schools letter, to discuss at the next meeting. For fund raising, Dick Lynch offered party trays for the Historical Society to sell at the Sheridan Celebrates on September 18, at the booth which will promote the Historical Society.

Pamphlet for Sheridan Celebrates President Hutcheson is preparing the pamphlet for the Sheridan Celebrates program; this year the topic is schools.
