Record of Proceedings April 27, 1995

Call to Order The meeting was called to order by the President at 8:10 p.m.

Roll Call Present: Bonita Hutcheson, Richard Lynch, Cliff Mueller and Charles West. Absent: Earl McCoy. Also present Eddie Kanoza from South Suburban.

Approval of Minutes A motion was made by Cliff Mueller, seconded by Dick Lynch, to approve the minutes of March 23, 1995 as presented.

Civic Minds Roster A roster of the Civic Minds Committee has been given to the Sheridan Historical Society.

Historic Sites Photographs of Historic sites were shown. This goes along with the list of sites given to the City Council.

Historic Recognition Ordinance A revised Ordinance on Historic Recognition of properties was distributed for comment. This stresses the value of recognition. Additional work will need to be done on the Ordinance before it can be given to the Council.

Davis Land Mr. Mueller has not been able to contact Mrs. Davis, but he did talk to the County Assessor. If the land is "given" to the Historical Society, there would be no property taxes. He will continue to work on this.
