Call to order The meeting was called to order by the President, Cliff Mueller, at 7:30 p.m.

Roll Call Present: Dick Lynch, Earl McCoy, Clifford Mueller, and Bonita Hutcheson.

Approval of the minutes A motion was made by Earl McCoy to approve the minutes of August 24, 1995 as presented. Seconded by Dick Lynch and carried.

Treasurer's Report In the absence of the Treasurer, Cliff Mueller reported in savings, we have \$5,040.47 and in the checking account \$171.31.

A bill from the secretary for copying and mailing the minutes for September, October and November was presented in the amount of \$19.17. A motion was made by Earl McCoy, seconded by Dick Lynch to pay this bill, motion carried.
