April 20, 1998

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Cliff Mueller at 9:00 p.m. Present for the roll call: Cliff Mueller, Charles West, and Bonita Hutcheson.

Approval of the minutes The minutes of March 17, 1998 were approved as printed.

Treasurer's Report. The Treasurer, Charles West, reported that there is \$8,163.13 in the Savings, and \$46.20 in the checking account. The Secretary, Bonita Hutcheson, presented a bill for the printing and mailing of the minutes, in the amount of \$7.00. It was approved for payment. Bonita Hutcheson paid dues.
