Record of Proceedings

July 24, 2000

A meeting of the Board was called to order by Chairman Cliff Mueller at 7:30 p.m. Present for the meeting Cliff Mueller, Bonita Hutcheson, and Charles West, Earl McCoy, Bill Carter, Shirley West, Ray Sample, Dallas Hall.

The minutes of May 2000 were not available for reading.

The treasurer, Charles West reported that there was \$11,143.81 in the savings, and \$68.16 in the checking. Bill from Bonita Hutcheson for printing and mailing of \$17.68 was approved for payment.

A membership list was passed around for correction. It will be sent with the next mailing.

Earl brought some photos of the old hotel. This was first named the Star Hotel, later the Mountain View Hotel, but called the Fort Logan Hotel. Mr. Carter was on the fire department when this burned in the early 1960's. He said that it was burned nearly to the ground. Bonita recalled that the city had trouble getting the owner of the land to pay for clean up after the fire and the cost had to be assessed as a lien on the property by the city.

Several members owe dues for the year. They will receive a reminder.

Discussion was held on the dedication of the light rail station at Oxford and Santa Fe.

Bonita was authorized to purchase a stamp "Property of the Sheridan Historical Society".

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:07 p.m.
