The meeting was called to order by Cliff Mueller at 7:06 pm.

Board Members present: Roger Rowland, Bonita Hutcheson, and Chuck West. Absent: Bill Carter and Rowena Yarbrough. Bill Carter has had open heart surgery and is doing well.

A motion was made by Roger, seconded by Cliff to approve the minutes of November 24, 2014. Motion carried

Roger present the treasurer's report, see exhibit A. Total funds in the account are \$10,043.44. Cash was received in September \$32.50 and in October \$30.00. A motion was made by Chuck and seconded by Cliff to approve the report.

A motion was made by Chuck and seconded by Cliff to authorize a check in the amount of \$1,633.00 to pay 'Alpine Trophy's' for the Isaac McBroom plaque and , to move \$2,200.00 from the savings to use for this purpose. Motion carried.
